Association of Women in Agriculture Bylaws Article VI Section II:

F. Secretary

- h. The Secretary will notify and award strikes to those members who do not follow the AWA Dress Code for all meetings and mandatory meetings/events.
 - i. The first offense will result in a verbal or written warning.
 - ii. The second offense and greater will result in a strike/offense.

- The items in bold are required, all others are listed as appropriate options
- Skirts and dresses should be longer than fingertips when arms are straight down at the side
- Shirts and dresses should have an appropriate neckline

Business Professional:

- **Collared blazer/jacket**
- Dress pants/professional skirt with dress shirt
- Professional dress (no spaghetti straps)
- **Dress shoes/boots (close-toed, no sneakers)**
- **Name tag**

Business Casual:

- Dress pants/professional skirt with dress shirt/sweater
- Professional dress (no spaghetti straps)
- **Dress shoes/boots (close-toed, no sneakers)**
- **Name tag**

Farmer Casual:

- Jeans or dress pants (no leggings or ripped jeans)
- Nice shirt or sweater (no t-shirts or sweatshirts)
- Close-toed shoes
